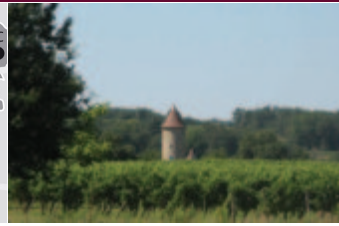

BORDEAUX RED SUPERIOR



THE VINEYARD

This region consists of limestone plateaux at around 100m above sea level, hence its name "Bordeaux's high country". Wines of the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation are produced in the vineyard zone of the Gironde. The wines must conform to rigorous quality criteria and are made from grapes from selected vineyard parcels and older vines. The red Bordeaux Supérieur is characterised by great aromatic complexity combining ripe fruits, floral aromas, spice and often a hint of oak.

HISTORY

Situated in Mauriac, between the Dordogne and the Garonne, Château de l'Enclos has been in the Farges family for 8 generations. Since 1995, brothers Bernard and Christian have been running the estate, applying innovative agricultural practices which are respectful of the environment. After several expansions, the vineyard surface today is around 92 hectares.

WINEMAKING AND AGEING

Destemming and crushing of the grapes. Alcoholic fermentation at controlled temperature with selected yeasts and maceration of the skins. It takes around 3 weeks to obtain a rounded wine with good structure. Part of the blend (about 20 to 30%) is aged in oak to add complexity to the wine's aromas without excessive oakiness.



GRAPE VARIETIES

65% Merlot, 30% Cabernet sauvignon, 5% Cabernet franc



FOOD PAIRINGS

Serve at between 16 and 18°C with meat and cheeses.



TASTING

Vivid red colour of medium depth. Ripe fruit and slightly toasty on the nose. Round on the palate with black fruit notes combined with well-integrated oak. Good length.



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
